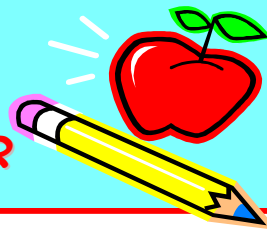

New for Algebra I and II students!

The NJDOE will administer the End of Course Algebra I Test in May 2010 to all students in grades 7-12 taking Algebra I or its equivalent. The End of Course Algebra I Test will be administered on May 24 (regular) and May 27, 2010 (make-up).

The department will pilot the Algebra II Test to a limited number of districts in May 2010, to assist districts in aligning their mathematics curricula appropriately. The Algebra II test may be administered any days within the May 17 through May 28 window, as long as students are not taking more than one statewide assessment the same day.



Getting Ready for the SATs/ACTs

The number one way to study for the SAT or ACT is to READ! The more you read, the better you will become at picking out important details, thinking outside the box, and understanding difficult vocabulary. Your writing and math skills will also improve. The best part is that you can start this great study skill at any age. The sooner you start, the better your scores will be. So head to the library and pick up a new book!

What's New on the NJ ASK?

The NJ ASK has made a few changes on the math sections. While one cannot know exactly what will be on the test, it is important to know how the test is formatted.

For grades 5-8, there are more items overall including more constructed response items. There is also a new question type called the short constructed response. Knowing what each question type is looking for will help students achieve the best score possible.

Reading and Writing Workshops
